

PARKS & RECREATION GOLF COURSE MAINTENANCE FACILITY STORM WATER MAINTENANCE PLAN



General Good Housekeeping BMPs

1. Complete quarterly comprehensive, quarterly visual, and weekly visual inspections as required to inspect BMPs and identify maintenance and cleaning required.
2. Inspect/clean storm water system facilities as needed, but annually at a minimum.
3. Sweep paved areas regularly and as identified during inspections.
4. Take vehicles in need of maintenance to Public Works Fleet Shop as quickly as possible. Use drip pans to catch oil leaks and dry absorbent as needed.
5. Store equipment, tools, and batteries properly.
6. Store fuels, solvents, oils, paints, herbicides, pesticides, and fertilizer in proper storage containers, with adequate secondary containment where required, and verify in good condition.
7. Keep floors inside buildings clean and neat.
8. Maintain garbage containers in good repair and stored properly.
9. Store and dispose of empty barrels and containers properly.
10. Maintain curb clear of dirt/debris.
11. Wash vehicles, mowers, and equipment at Public Works Operations Facility.
12. Follow SOPs for landscape maintenance and use of herbicides, pesticides, and fertilizers.
13. Follow Spill Prevention and Response Plan for spills.
